At this time Nominations for the position of Chairman were offered. Mr. Schaffer nominated Mr. Mender and then Mr. Pontone seconded that nomination for Mr. Cumiskey to continue as Chairman. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockleigh Sewerage Authority that whenever any service charge pertaining to any parcel of real property has not been paid as of the due date or within ten (10) days of the date thereof, that interest on such service charge shall accrue at the rate of one and one-half $(1\frac{1}{2}\%)$ percent per month; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of the within resolution shall be forwarded to the Collector of the Borough in accordance with the provisions of the Statute.

Minutes of the July 12, 2021 meeting were tabled due to lack of voting quorum.

Minutes of the February 1, 2021 meeting were presented for approval. Motion offered by Mr. Pontone, seconded by Mr. Cumiskey to approve the February 1, 2021 meeting minutes as presented. All Members present voted in the affirmative, except, Mrs. Feulner, Mr. Schaffer, Mr. Photidadis and Mr. Mender, who abstained from the vote, to approve the February 1, 2021 minutes. The Motion passed.

Minutes of the December 6, 2021 meeting were presented for approval. Mr. Pontone noted that Mr. Hansen was listed as both present and absent for that meeting. The Secretary confirmed that Mr. Hansen was absent for that meeting and that correction would be made. No further discussion took place. Motion offered by Mr. Mender, seconded by Mr. Pontone to approve the minutes of December 6, 2021 with the correction noted above. All Members present voted in the affirmative to approve the minutes except Mr. Cumiskey, who abstained from the vote. The Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Cumiskey reported the pump station generator is awaiting some parts for repairs needed. No other business was reported.

FINANCIAL BUSINESS/ PAYMENT OF CLAIMS:

Resolution 2022-7 presented for consideration which was the Bill Lists for December 30, 2021 and February 7, 2022. Brief discussion took place regarding the \$9,322.53 amount represented on the December 30, 2021 Bill list. The CFO confirmed that amount represented the reimbursement amount from the RSA to the Borough of Rockleigh under the Shared Services Agreement which allows for 24.09% reimbursement for expenses occurred by the Borough. Discussion ended. A Motion offered by Mr. Mender, seconded by Mr. Schaffer to approve the Bill Lists for December 31, 2021 and February 7, 2022 representing the RSA contractual obligations in the amount of \$13,960.96. The Roll Call vote was recorded as follows:

The meeting was opened to the public by a Motion offered by Mr. Pontone, seconded by Mr. Mender. All Members present voted in the affirmative. The Motion passed. No public was present for the meeting. A Motion to close the meeting to the public was offered by Mr. Pontone seconded by Mr. Schaffer. All Members present voted in the affirmative. The Motion passed.

CORRESPONDENCE: Mr. Cumiskey briefly discussed the correspondence from Electrical Power Systems. Mr. Cumiskey noted parts have been delayed to repair the generator, and; therefore, at the present time, the generator at the pump station is down. The pump is working fine. Mr. Cumiskey stated that should the need arise for the need to rent a generator for a temporary time period that will be arranged until the repairs can be made. Discussion ended.

With no further business to come before the RSA, a Motion was offered by Mr. Mender, seconded by Mr. Schaffer to adjourn the meeting. All Members present voted in the affirmative to adjourn the meeting. The Motion passed.

EXHIBIT A

Borough of Rockleigh Sewage Pump Station, Paris Avenue Lockout / Tagout Requirement for Contractors

Purpose;

Any contractor required to enter the Rockleigh sewage pumping station on Paris Ave for servicing and/or repairs shall have a "lockout / tagout program that is in compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration Standard 29 CFR 1910.147, "The Control of Hazardous Energy". The program shall cover the control of hazardous energy for the contractor employees and any public for protection against injury and/or death, including equipment damage from unexpected startup, energizing and / or release of stored energy. The program shall apply to all sources of energy, including, but not limited to: mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, water pressure, pneumatic, chemical, and thermal energy. This program shall not apply to qualified/authorized person(s) for inspection services who do not require control of any energy sources for their inspection(s).

Repair / Maintenance Agreements;

Prior to any contract award for maintenance and repair of equipment within the Rockleigh Sewage Pump Station it shall be ascertained that the contractor does have a program in compliance to 29 CFR 1910.147 (lockout / tagout). The contractor shall state in writing that they can comply with the procedure when returning bid requirements. A copy of this procedure shall be supplied to each contractor and is included as part of the bid process. Failure to have such a program shall disqualify the contractor from any work which requires OSHA compliance to this standard. Lockout and/or tagout shall be performed only by the authorized contractors who are performing the servicing or maintenance.

Notification and coordination;

Whenever outside repair /servicing personnel are to be engaged in activities covered by the scope and application of this procedure, the contractor shall inform the Rockleigh Borough Office 201-768-4217 of their intent to enter the pumping station for repair or service, including any coordination of lockout and /or tagout that may be required. During the activity of lockout / tagout for repair, the contractor performing the work shall have complete control of any persons entering the station until all work is completed and the station is turned back to Rockleigh. Notification sequence for entry and coordination is as follows; the Sewage Authority Administrator - 1st, the Sewage Authority Chairman - 2nd and if unable to make contact with one of the first two, the Mayor. Also applies to emergency work. Documentation of coordination with the Borough of Rockleigh shall be retained and a copy forwarded to the Borough office.

Failure to adhere to Lockout / Tagout: Contractors failing to adhere to the provisions of the OSHA Hazardous Energy Control Standard will be asked to terminate their work until their program is brought into compliance.
